**St. Johns County, FL** – All Tropical Storm Isaias-related prohibitions on swimming at St. Johns County beaches, including the Fort Matanzas National Monument beaches, will be lifted at dawn on Tuesday, August 4. Beach visitors are asked to exercise caution when swimming. In addition, on-beach driving is anticipated to be reinstated at 8 a.m. on Tuesday; however, gate openings may be delayed due to tidal flooding.
