NEIGHBORHOOD BILL OF RIGHTS NOTIFICATION

You have received this NOTICE because you are the designated representative for a registered Association under the Neighborhood Bill of Rights Ordinance (No. 2007-01) and/or an infrastructure improvement project is planned nearby. Details regarding a St. Johns County pavement management project scheduled for your area have been provided below. Please be advised, umbrella associations are provided notice as a courtesy and do not share the same rights afforded to Neighborhood Associations as defined by the Neighborhood Bill of Rights Ordinance.

Project Name: Ponte Vedra Boulevard South Asphalt Milling, Resurfacing and Striping

Project Location(s): Ponte Vedra Boulevard from Corona Road South to SR-A1A

<u>Project Description:</u> Contractor will establish Maintenance of Traffic (MOT). Expect temporary single lane closures with flagmen throughout project duration. Heavy machinery will mill 3.5 inches of existing roadway asphalt from edge of pavement to edge of pavement. Expect noise and vibration. New asphalt overlay consists of a 2 lift process. The first lift is 2 inches of SP12.5 asphalt and the second lift is 1.5 inches of SP9.5 asphalt. Driveways, mailboxes, sod/landscaping and any other areas impacted within or outside of the Right-of-Way will be restored to pre-construction conditions throughout project limits. Temporary roadway paint striping is applied during 1st and then 2nd lift of new asphalt overlays. Permanent thermoplastic striping will be placed following 14 to 30 days of asphalt cure time. St. Johns County will have two full time inspectors on site at all times during pavement operations.

Approximate Date of Commencement: May 11, 2020 – MOT & offset staking edge of pavement

<u>Project Duration:</u> Approximately 10 days, Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM. Under some circumstances, extended or weekend hours may be necessary. Hours subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen conditions. Updates provided via Variable Message Boards during project. <u>NOTE: A JEA Potable Water Main Replacement Project is scheduled from Corona Road North to the County line starting August 2020.</u>
